*Enhances public image and status of our school.

*Prepares students for the future when they work in work places that have dress and safety codes.

*Ensures students are safely and appropriately dress for school activities and our environment.

GUIDELINES

Children are expected to wear school uniform during school hours to and from school and on school excursions. Parents/carers are asked to assist us to uphold the policy by ensuring that students wear a uniform that is neat, clean and tidy to school every day.

WINTER UNIFORM:

As for summer uniform and:

Maroon tracksuit pants

Maroon Jumper or zip jacket with school logo

HATS

Chapman Valley Primary School is a sun smart school through the Cancer Council. Students will wear a Chapman Valley Primary School wide brimmed hat whilst outside participating in play or activities.

JEWELLERY

Students are discouraged from wearing jewellery and valuable items. These items can present a safety risk during certain educational activities.

HAIR

Students with long hair should have hair tied back in order to not pose a safety risk.

FOOTWEAR

Slip-on footwear and thongs are not appropriate footwear for school.
